You will enter your contractor's unique ID number, your name, the address where the rebate check will be mailed, and some product information regarding your qualifying Rheem HVAC purchase.



Rebate FAQ's

Listed below are some of the most frequently asked questions about the CashBack Promotion. For full details, be sure to ask your participating contractor.

• How do I submit my rebate request? –

After your purchase of a qualifying HVAC system you can file for your rebate online at www.rheemrebate.com.



After submission of all required information, you will need to print out your Rebate Confirmation sheet, sign it and mail it along with a copy of your installing contractor's invoice to our rebate processing center.

• **How long do I have to submit my rebate request?** – Rebate requests can be submitted throughout the promotion time period (April 15 through November 15, 2010). Plus you have until November 30, 2010 to postmark all of your rebate information.

• When can I expect my rebate check?

You should receive your rebate check within 6 weeks of submission of **all qualifying materials**.

• What information do I need to submit my rebate request?

Here is what you will need to file for your rebate:

- Your installing contractor's unique ID number
- Your name and the address that you want the rebate check sent to
- The model numbers of **ALL QUALIFYING INSTALLED PRODUCTS** (must be on installing contractor's invoice)
- The serial numbers of your **QUALIFYING INDOOR AND OUTDOOR UNITS** (must be on installing contractor's invoice)



• What if I don't have access to a computer?

– You can still submit your rebate request on a manual form – ask your participating contractor for details and a copy of the form. Keep in mind that this may result in a delay in your rebate check.

• Where do I send all of my Rebate Request Information?

– The signed Rebate confirmation form (or the completed manual form) along with a copy of the installing contractor's invoice should be mailed to:

Information on the Federal Tax Stimulus

For the second consecutive year, certain qualifying systems are eligible for a federal tax credit when you file your 2010 tax return. If you qualify, you may receive up to a \$1,500 tax credit. Visit www.rheem.com and click on the "Federal Tax Credits" icon to learn about qualifying Rheem HVAC products. As always, you should consult your tax professional to determine your individual qualification for the tax credits.
